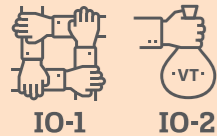

55% of the target trainee contribution achieved

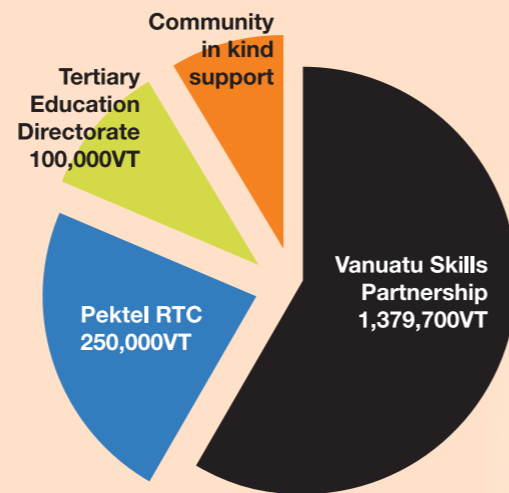
*N = 422. Target is 500vt/per participant through financial contributions or equivalent in-kind from participants, community and training providers

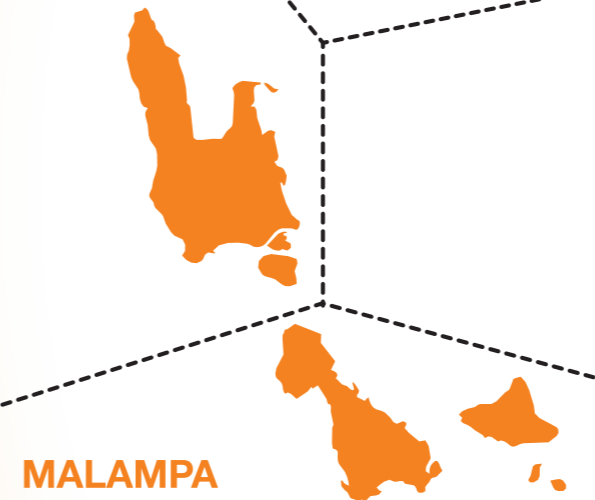

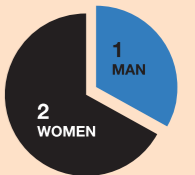
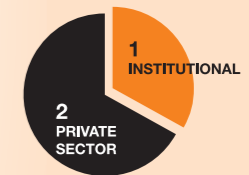
Vanuatu Skills Partnership has been working in partnership with Tertiary Education Directorate to engage the Australia Pacific Training Coalition (APTC) to deliver International Skills Training (IST) course for key partners.

The IST course was delivered in Luganville with participants from Malampa, Sanma and Torba, and in Port Vila with participants from Shefa and Tafea. In total 39 (9 women) trainers, coaches and managers completed the IST course.
