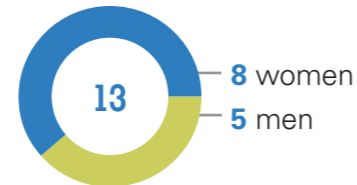

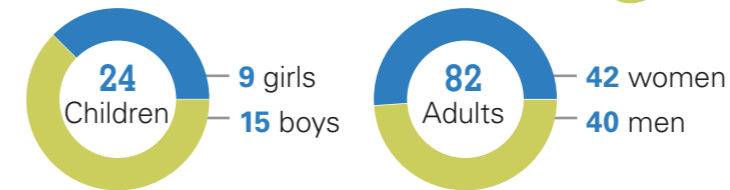
As part of COVID-19 preparation,
